LA CRONACA

PARTENZA (Siena – ore 11.27 – 174 gli atleti al via; non è partito Mohoric)

Avvio con andatura molto sostenuta. Al km 10, Price-Pejtersen, Dewulf, Askey, Swift, Petilli, Philipsen, Donovan, Reinderink, Foldager e Weiss hanno un vantaggio di 25" su Serrano Rodriguez; a 1'10" il gruppo. Al km 19, i dieci fuggitivi hanno un vantaggio di 2'25" sul gruppo che ha ripreso Serrano Rodriguez. Al km 35, il vantaggio dei fuggitivi è di 3'52". Media dopo un'ora di corsa: 43,750 km/h.

Al km 48, il vantaggio dei fuggitivi sul gruppo è di 4'22". Al km 61, il gruppo insegue i fuggitivi a 5'26". Media dopo due ore di corsa: 42,350 km/h.

La situazione resta cristallizzata. Al km 105, allungano in testa Askey, Donovan e Reinderink; poco dopo vengono raggiunti da Swift e Weiss. Al km 109, Foldager raggiunge i fuggitivi. Al km 113 (-100 km dall'arrivo), il vantaggio dei sei fuggitivi è di 2'28" sul gruppo. Al termine dello sterrato 8, il gruppo condotto dagli atleti UAE Team Emirates insegue i sei fuggitivi a 1'57". Media dopo tre ore di corsa: 41,450 km/h.

Al km 129 (inizio sterrato 9), i sei fuggitivi mantengono un vantaggio di 1'28". Si segnalano i ritiri di Ulissi e Scaroni. Al km 133, Swift solitario in testa. Dal gruppo, allungato e in forte rimonta, attaccano Pogačar e Pidcock. Al km 136, al comando Pogačar e Pidcock; prova a inseguire Swift. Al km 140, Swift raggiunge Pogačar e Pidcock in testa alla corsa; a 34" Askey, Donovan e Weiss. Al km 147, il vantaggio dei tre fuggitivi nei confronti del primo gruppo inseguitori è di 1'23". Al km 156, il ritardo degli inseguitori è di 1'08". Al km 164, caduta di Pogačar che riprende; resta solitario in testa Pidcock. Media dopo quattro ore di corsa: 41,200 km/h.

Al km 167, Pidcock attende il rientro di Pogačar che, nel frattempo, ha staccato Swift. Al km 175, il ritardo di Swift dalla coppia di testa è di 1'12". Al km 180, i due fuggitivi hanno un vantaggio di 1'12" sul gruppetto degli inseguitori che ha ripreso Swift. Al km 190, Wellens, Bilbao Lopez, Healy, Swift e Adria Oliveras inseguono la coppia di testa a 45". A -18,500 km dall'arrivo, Pogačar scatta solitario in testa. All'uscita dell'ultimo sterrato, il ritardo di Pidcock sale a 1'00". Ai -5 km dall'arrivo, il vantaggio di Pogačar su Pidcock è di 1'03".

Al triangolo rosso, Pogačar si avvia solitario verso la vittoria.

THE RACE REPORT

START: 174 riders are ready to get underway at the Fortezza Medicea in Siena. Mohoric is not at the line. Rolling together along the neutralised section, the riders reach km 0 at 11:27.

The pace picks up right after the start. Al km 10, Price-Pejtersen, Dewulf, Askey, Swift, Petilli, Philipsen, Donovan, Reinderink, Foldager and Weiss have opened a 25" gap over Serrano Rodriguez, and are leading the peloton by 1'10". At km 19, the peloton is trailing at 2'25", after bringing back Serrano Rodriguez. The gap rises further, to 3'52" at km 35. After the first hour of racing, the average speed is 43.750 kph.

At km 48, the break's lead is further up: 4'22". The gap reaches a maximum of 5'26" at km 61. Average speed after two hours of racing: 42.350 kph.

The situation settles. Askey, Donovan and Reinderink attack out of the front group at km 105. Swift and Weiss jump on their wheels shortly after. Foldager also manages to bridge across at km 109. At the -100 km mark (at km 113 of racing), the six breakaway riders are 2'28" up the road. When leaving gravel sector 8, the peloton—led by UAE Team Emirates—is trailing 1'57" behind. The average speed after three hours of racing is 41.450 kph.

At km 129 (start of gravel sector 9), the gap stands at 1'28". Ulissi and Scaroni abandon the race. At km 133, Swift is leading, solo. Pogačar and Pidcock attack out of the strung-out, returning peloton, hitting the front at km 136. Swift tries to keep their wheel. At km 140, Pogačar, Pidcock and Swift have a 34" lead over Askey, Donovan and Weiss. At km 147, the three escapees have a 1'23" leader over a first chasing peloton. At km 156, the gap is down to 1'08". Pogačar crashes at km 164, but manages to get back in the saddle. Pidcock remains alone out front. Average speed after four hours of racing: 41.200 kph.

At km 167, Pidcock waits for Pogačar to get back to the front. In the meantime, Swift has lost contact. At km 175, Swift is trailing 1'12" behind the leading duo. At km 180, Swift is brought back by the chasing peloton; the gap still stands at 1'12". At km 190, Wellens, Bilbao Lopez, Healy, Swift and Adria Oliveras are trailing 45" behind the leading duo. Pogačar puts the hammer down, with 18.5 km to go. Upon leaving the last gravel sector, he is leading Pidcock by 1'00". At 5 km out, Pidcock is 1'03" down the road.

At the *flamme rouge*, Pogačar—safely out of reach—soloes to the line.

FINISH (Siena – km 213)

Pogačar wins the race in 5h13'58" (average speed: 40.704 kph), ahead of Pidcock (+1'24"), Wellens (+2'12"), Healy (+3'23"), Bilbao Lopez (+4'20"), Nielsen (+4'26"), Vermeersch (+4'29"), Valgren (+4'37"), Van Eetvelt (+4'47"), Adria Oliveras (+5'06") in the first 10 spots. The rest of the peloton follows.

TV COVERAGE

Strade Bianche Crédit Agricole and Strade Bianche Women Elite Crédit Agricole was broadcast globally thanks to a wide network of broadcasters ensuring live coverage, news updates, and highlights.

In Italy, the women's race was aired from 11:45 AM on the **RaiPlay** platform, while the men's race was broadcast on **Rai2** starting at 2:05 PM.

Discovery+ streamed both events live and on-demand for the international audience at the same times, allowing fans to experience the key moments in real time. Europe's most southern northern classic was also broadcast at the same times on **Eurosport 2** and, in the United Kingdom, on **TNT3**.

Across Europe, several broadcasters provided coverage of the race. In the Netherlands, **NOS** delivered news updates, as did **VTM** in Belgium. Belgian fans were also able to watch the men's race live on **RTBF** and **VRT**. In Switzerland, **SRG** provided live coverage of the men's race, while in Slovenia, **Planet TV** offered both live broadcasting and highlights.

Beyond Europe, in Japan, **JSPORTS** aired the race live, bringing the excitement of the event to cycling fans in Asia. In Australia, **SBS** provided live coverage of both the men's and women's races, while in Latin America, **DirectTV** broadcast the event live along with highlight summaries. Fans in New Zealand, the MENA region, and Africa were also able to follow the competition thanks to Staylive's live streaming services. Meanwhile, in Colombia, **RTVC** focused on covering the women's race. North America was also involved in the event's broadcast. In Canada, **FloSports** provided live coverage, while in the United States, the race was aired live on **MAX**, giving American fans the opportunity to experience every moment of the action along the iconic Crete Senesi. Thanks to this global coverage, cycling fans from all over the world were able to follow the thrilling battles of the season's first Italian UCI WorldTour classic

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
